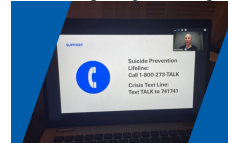




President John's Message

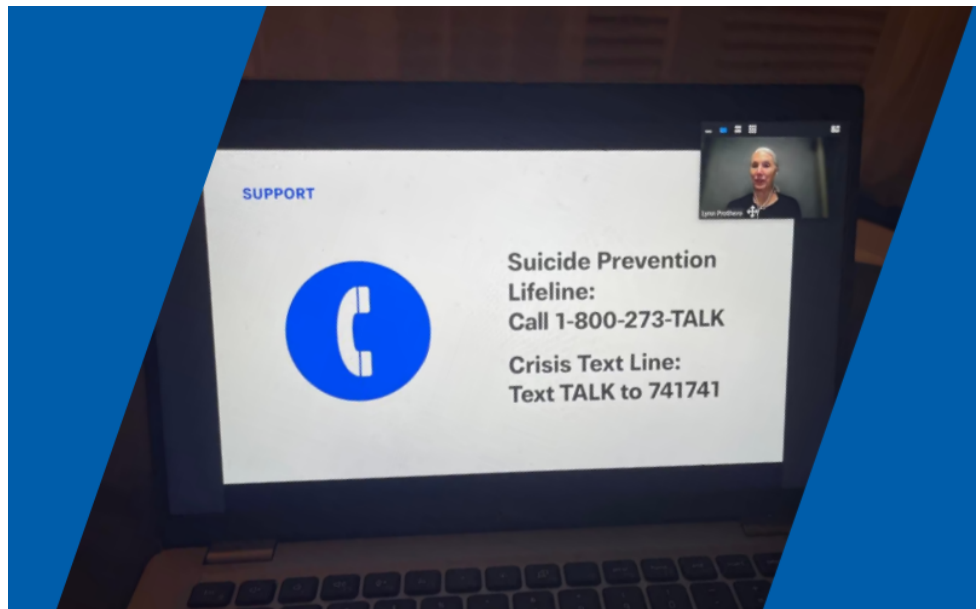
