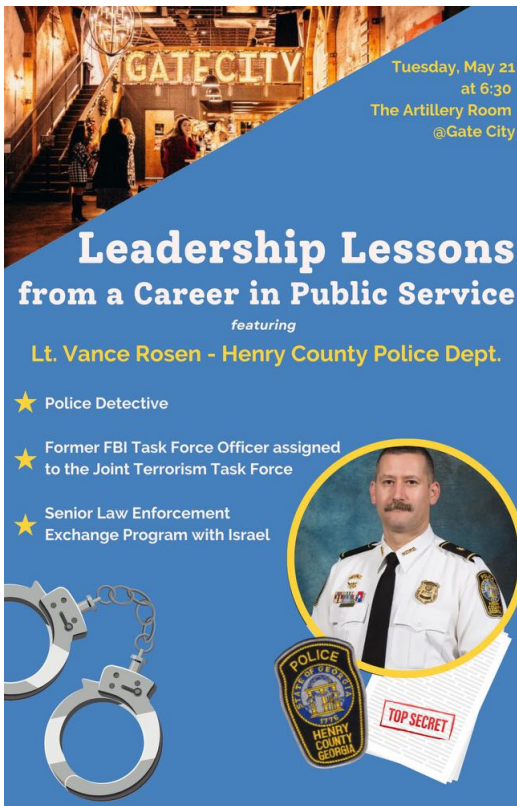

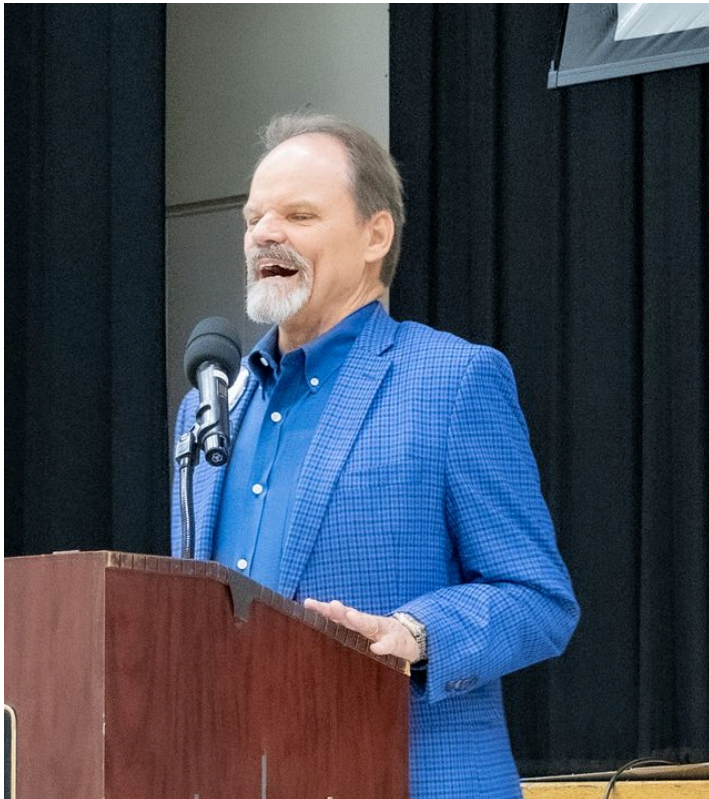
TO VOLUNTEER:
